## WEEKLY CARP LIFE MEETINGS

- 10-15 min Check-In
- 5-15 min CARP Talk
- 10-15 min Discussion
- 10-15 min Principle Application



**Discussion** is with the question 'What did CARP talk trigger in you?'

**Principle application** is when everyone shares their action plan to practice the principle. e.g.) "I want to improve my relationship with my parents so I will have deep talk this week."

Here is the key thing that they do in their CARP society or Club.

**Check-in** is asking people if they practiced what they wanted to from last week.

**CARP talk** is based on Principle, but only with personal experiences rather than theology.

It's only 1 hour every week so that people have enough time to focus on their studies but it's also very effective in helping people become better.


## OFFICER POSITIONS & ROLES
