Establishment of the Inter-Denominational Christian Association (November 7, 1966, A-seo-won, Jung-gu, Seoul)

A ceremony marking the foundation of the Inter-Denominational Christian Association was held on November 7, 1966 at A-seo-won, in Jung-gu, Seoul. This was the result of the Christianity based interdenominational activities that had been held since 1965.

True Father said, "If a hundred members become people central to creating harmony, they can be remembered by Heaven. To bring about harmony, inter-denominational activities must be carried out to a degree where one would even fall into debt for it." When first established, it was launched under the name the "Christian Inter-Denominational Movement Headquarters" but was renamed the "Inter-Denominational Christian Association" eight years later in October 1974.
