True Parents' Meeting with Kim Il Sung December 6, 1991, Hamheung, North Korea



On December 6, True Parents had a historic meeting with Kim II Sungat Jusuk Palace in Majeon, Hamheung.

They exchanged a letter of agreement for peaceful unification based on a joint statement that contained ten articles regarding such promises as the hosting of a North Korean–South Korean summit meeting, peaceful resolution to the issue of North Korea's nuclear armament and the hosting of reunions between the ten million separated Korean family members.

In his statement, True Father said, "I am not going to the house of my enemy but rather that of my homeland, and that of my brother."
