Meeting between True Parents and Soviet Leader Gorbachev April 11, 1990 - Kremlin Palace, Moscow

A private meeting between True Parents and President Mikhail Gorbachev took place at the Kremlin Palace in Moscow on April 11, 1990. Following an hour-long conversation with the delegation, including some ex-heads of state, that was attending the eleventh World Media Conference, True Parents met President Gorbachev for thirty minutes to discuss the unification of North Korea and South Korea, along with religious freedom, diplomatic ties, and economic cooperation between Korea and the Soviet Union. The media conference, as well as the third Summit Council for World Peace, was held at the Moscow International Trade Center until April 13, with 600 participants from 65 nations in attendance.
