Certification Qualifications

- 1. Be currently Blessed in good standing (Unification and Clergy couples)
- Have attended the Unification Theological Seminary or another seminary, and/or completed a Divine Principle 7-Day Program.
- 3. Be familiar with the steps involved in the Marriage Blessing process, have a basic understanding of their significance, and be able to guide couples participating in the Blessing ceremony with confidence and clarity.
- Submit a recent photo of your couple as well as Marriage Blessing documentation (Blessing certificate, Blessing photo or other document).
- 5. Complete the Blessing Officiator Commitment Pledge in the application form.

The term of certification is one year from the date of approval, available for renewal through re-submitting an application, studying this Blessing Officiator Handbook and completing a "Refresher Quiz." An official Certified Blessing Officator Certificate is issued to each approved couple.


