Philippines Hosts Youth Leadership Training 3-Day Workshop for Asia Pacific

A Youth Leadership Training (YLT) 3-day workshop for Asia Pacific was held in the Philippines from January 27 to 29, 2025. Four members of the Asia Pacific YLT regional special team returned to the Philippines after completing missionary activities in Cambodia, Hong Kong, Macau, Singapore, Malaysia, and Brunei over a period of 3 months and 11 days (October 14, 2024 to January 26, 2025) to participate in this workshop.
