

FFWPU & UPF Canada's Hyojeong Family Festival and True Parents Theory 2-Day Workshop

A "Canada Hyojeong Family Festival," jointly hosted by the Family Federation for World Peace and Unification and the Universal Peace Federation of Canada, was held on February 2 in Downsview, Toronto, coinciding with Chinese New Year as an event to revisit the values of hyojeong (filial heart) and family.

The festival featured various programs where families could mingle, including traditional crafts, tea tastings, and games. In particular, an essay contest on filial piety was held under the theme "Beautiful Time with Parents," where participants wrote reflections while recalling memories with their parents, reminding them of the meaning of filial piety.

A Canadian True Parents Theory 2-day workshop was held over two days from February 8-9 in Camrose, Alberta. The workshop also saw high participation through online Zoom. The event, led by Dr. Katsumi Kambashi, consisted of nine lectures on topics such as "True Parents' Heart" and "The Meaning of the Only Begotten Daughter." Through the lectures, participants had time to more deeply understand True Parents' love and status. They also reflected on the historical and providential significance of True Mother's advent, and shared reflections that they were "deeply moved by True Mother's providential and historical significance as the young generation 'Mother of Pure Water.'"
