The closing ceremony was led by Lee Chung-woo, who was appointed Chief Director of the Cheon Mu Won Central Administration. The program included the singing of the Cheon Il Guk anthem, recitation of the Family Pledge, entrance of True Parents, a formal Gyeongbae, and the presentation of gifts by various providential organizations: The World Mission Headquarters, Universal Peace Federation, Elder Pastors' Association, Korean Religions Association, Women's Federation for World Peace, Cheonwonsa, HyoJeong International Foundation for Environmental Peace, and the International Family Association.
