

Colombia's Legislators Global Ambassadors for Peace Appointment Ceremony

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Congresswomen appointed as Global Peace Ambassadors lead peace activities in local communities

The May 3 Colombia Family Federation "Global Ambassadors for Peace Appointment Ceremony" for female legislators at the Colombian National Congress was designed to emphasize the pivotal role of women's leadership and enable the new Peace Ambassadors to expand their contributions to peacebuilding. Five hundred women leaders from across Colombia attended the inauguration ceremony, during which more than 300 female city and county council members were appointed as Global Ambassadors for Peace.
