The conference is part of a series of European Leadership Conferences on issues of pressing concern for Europe and the world, held at the United Nations in Geneva and Vienna, UNESCO in Paris, National Parliaments in the United Kingdom and Norway, and in the Presidential Palace in Malta. We expect participants from all over Europe and have invited a delegation of politicians, academics, NGO and youth representatives from Russia and former Soviet Union nations in response to their kind invitation to Moscow in April of this year for a conference entitled, *"Russia-Europe Dialogue - Peace and Security in Multicultural Societies at a Time of Global Crisis"*. International participants would arrive on the 11th October evening and be accommodated in the NH Danube City Hotel or other hotels close to the Vienna International Centre or Danube River. A fee of 320 Euros will include a two night stay (departure on 13th Oct evening) sharing a twin bedded room with meals and all aspects of the programme on 12th and 13th October (extra nights €70, single accommodation extra €50 per night).

A ground pass is required to enter Vienna International Centre (VIC). If you do not have a permanent pass, please register following indications on **www.weltfriede.at** not later than October 8th 2012. Those who would like to enter the VIC and attend the conference on October 12th are **requested to present their identity document** at Gate 1 of the VIC. The VIC, 1220 Wien, Wagramerstrasse 5, is best reached by Subway U1 (Kaisermühlen). It is in walking distance from the NH Danube City Hotel.
