Second Public Hearing on the Development of a Lecture Plan Teaching the Theology of True Parents for the Restoration of Christianity

On February 19th, a gathering took place at the Cheon Sung Wang Lim Palace, the Second Public Hearing on the Development of a Lecture Plan Teaching the Theology of True Parents for the Restoration of Christianity.

Guided by True Mother's profound message from last December, the hearing focused on awakening Christianity from its slumber. True Mother had emphasized the need to uncover the essence of the Heavenly Parent and the True Parents, which have remained veiled in Christian history, along with unveiling the truths of the 2,000-year history of Christian providential history. Their collective effort aimed at realigning Christianity with the theology of True Parents.

The hearing was meticulously structured, beginning with an opening declaration and a bow of respect. This was followed by a report prayer and opening remarks, setting a reflective tone for the event. A series of presentations then unfolded, each accompanied by a question and answer session, fostering engaging debates and in-depth discussions. The event was further enriched by insightful messages from Song Yong Cheon of FFWPU-International and Michael Balcomb, the Regional President of Heavenly Europe. The hearing concluded with a closing declaration, encapsulating the profound deliberations and commitments.

This event served not only as a platform for theological exchange but also as a beacon for the future direction of religious understanding within the Christian community.
