- 1. Education Program: the first semester of 2015 Korean language course at Sun Moon University (a one-year program)
- 2. Number of scholarship students to be accepted: 10 maximum
- 3. Benefits for the scholarship students:
 - a) Full tuition for the Korean language course
 - b) Support for food expenses including the food expenses on weekends
 - c) Support for the dormitory fee
 - d) Refer to the attached guidebook for more details
- 4. Applicant Requirements (must satisfy all qualifications below):
 - a) The applicant is a citizen, or resident of the mission nation (Korean citizens are ineligible)
 - b) University graduates or those with an equivalent education or higher
 - c) A person who commits to completing the entire Korean language course (one year)
 - d) A person who is recommended by the regional president or national leader in the mission nation
 - e) A person who commits to returning to the mission nation and serving in a public mission as a national leader candidate under the direction of the regional president after completing the scholarship program



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- f) A person who has served at least 1 year of public mission in the mission nation (as a minister or working full time in any of the various organizations of FFWPU)
- g) A person who has served at least 3 years in a life of devotion (The devotion standard is based on their region.)
- h) A person with no physical or mental disabilities (Pregnant women are also ineligible.)

5. Selection Procedure:

Each regional headquarters must collect documents submitted by the applicants and send them to the international headquarters. The Wonmo Pyeongae Foundation will conduct the final selection. Refer to the guidebook for more details.

A. Entry

Students must arrive Korea before the opening day of the 1st semester in 2015.

- * Detailed schedule for the day of entry will be notified later.
- Students are required to get a D-4 visa. Visit the Korean Embassy or Korean Consulate in your country of residence with the invitation letter from Sun Moon University.
- Students are advised to prepare sufficient funds to cover personal expenses during their stay in Korea. Parttime jobs are not allowed for students with a D-4 visa.
- Prior to arrival, students should be informed about the Korean climate, customs, and culture.

C. Korean Language Course

D. Cancellation of Scholarship Selection

- When any document for scholarship application has been found to contain false information.
- When a scholarship student does not enter Korea by the opening day of the 1st semester in 2015.
- When the admission of Sun Moon University Korean language course is canceled.
- When a scholarship student is not allowed to move into the dorm due to health issues.

E. Suspension of Scholarship Issuance

- When a scholarship student has violated the written pledge.
- When a scholarship student is punished by Sun Moon University or involved in certain forms of political
 activities.
- When a scholarship student has detracted the reputation of FFWPU International Headquarters, Sun Moon University, and Wonmo Pyeongae Foundation by hurting the dignity of the scholarship.
- When the student has violated the guidelines and regulations set by FFWPU International Headquarters, Sun Moon University, and Wonmo Pyeongae Foundation.
- During the Korean Language course, scholarship students must attend all classes (attendance must exceed 90% of total class time) including summer and winter sessions. If a student has any special reason to be absent from a class, he or she must receive permission from his or her teacher in advance.

11. 질의응답 / Frequently Asked Questions

What is an insurance fee?

Every international student at Sun Moon University joins the insurance service provided by Sun Moon University, unless a student has already joined another international insurance service.

If I go eat outside of school, will I be reimbursed?

No, if you eat anywhere other than the school cafeteria, you will not be reimbursed. You will be responsible for your personal expenses.

What happens to the international students during winter/summer session?

Students in the Wonmo Pyeongae Global Leaders Scholarship Program are expected to stay at the dormitory during the winter/summer session, since there will be education programs. The information about the educational programs during the winter/summer will be announced later. The school cafeteria is open during the winter/summer session.

What is the situation regarding medical coverage and medical insurance?

There is a health center on the first floor of the Student Building on campus. Please refer to the table below for descriptions of medical coverage. Please contact Sun Moon University for the process of getting the medical coverage.

HOON DOK HAE, SUNDAY SERVICES, EXPECTED LIFE OF FAITH

Hoon Dok Hae

All students are required to attend Hoon Dok Hae. This means that each student must attend Hoon Dok Hae from start to finish without being late, while refraining from activities that are not part of Hoon Dok Hae. (90% minimum attendance at Hoon Dok Hae is required). Three instances of arriving late are regarded as one absence.

나. 소그룹:

지속적인 영적 성장과 안정적인 신앙생활을 위하여 모든 장학생은 담당자가 구성하는 소그룹에 소속하여 일정한 책임을 다해야 한다.

A. Hoon Dok Hae Rules

- Hoon Dok Hae sessions start in the morning at 8:30.
- Focus on Hoon Dok Hae with a sincere attitude.
- The Hoon Dok Hae time may change depending on the situation.

B. Excused absences

Church-related activities including but not limited to the following:

- Special events at Cheongpyeong
- Any public event which the coordinator determines is a reasonable absence

(Consult the coordinator prior to the absence.)

Sunday Service

All students are required to attend Sunday services. This means that each student must attend Sunday service from start to finish, while refraining from activities that are not part of the Sunday service.

A. Excused absences
The Same as in Section 1.

Exemplary Lifestyle as a Missionary

- A. Activities beneath the standard of the church and/or the founding ideals will not be allowed, and any activities that undermine the dignity as of a missionary is prohibited.
- i. In case a student is found participating in these activities, students are to report that student directly to the coordinator.
- ii. Any violations of the above will result in a warning and consultation as described in Section 4.

B. Teams:

For the sake of continued spiritual growth and a stable life of faith, all students should belong to a small team that the coordinator organizes and fulfill certain responsibility as a team member.

1) 개인

4. 시행 및 경고 규정

가. 훈독회와 일요 예배

1) 무단 결석 하는 경우에 해당 학생은 담당자와 상담시간을 가져야 한다.

나. 경고 통지 : 교목실과 국제교류처를 통해 세계본부에서 경고처리를 할 수 있다.

다. 모든 장학생은 경고통지를 받으면 장학 자격을 상실한다.

라. 경고처리는 경고의 내용을 학생에게 공개한다. 경고내용은 해당 학생 소속 대륙회장에게 보고

i. Individuals

A. To be open to becoming a team leader if necessary (Becoming a leader is not mandatory, but one must be prepared to assume the role at all times.)

C. To report any cause of absence from Hoon Dok Hae or Sunday service to the team leader.

ii. Team leaders

A. To make sure team members attend Hoon Dok Hae (Monday–Friday) and Sunday services (weekly)

B. To submit the monthly activity report, including the team members' attendance, to the FFWPU International Headquarters (IHQ).

C. To support effective communication between the team members (students) and the FFWPU IHQ.

3. Communication FFWPU IHQ and the Regional Headquarters from the Students' Mission Area

A. Each student is to report the FFWPU IHQ and his or her regional headquarters using a form.

* Students will be notified about the form after enrollment

4. Enforcement and Warning Policy

A. Hoon Dok Hae and Sunday service

i. In case an unexcused absence occurs, the student will be required to set up a time to meet with the coordinator for a consultation.

B. Warnings can be issued by the FFWPU IHQ through the Office of International Affairs and the Chaplain's office

C. A notification of warning to the student will result in termination of the scholarship.

D. The content of the warning will be made known to the student and his or her regional headquarters.

5. Termination Policy

- A. In the event that a student has failed to keep the aforementioned conditions of the scholarship, the student will lose the scholarship.
- B. The FFWPU IHQ and the Wonmo Pyeongae Foundation have the following rights:
- i. To give warnings to students, as deemed necessary
- ii. To, in extreme cases, disqualify students from the scholarship program upon consent of the FFWPU IHQ and the Wonmo Pyeongae Foundation.
- 6. Information about special awards to be given to exemplary students that demonstrate active participation in public service and other events as a team leader or volunteer will be provided.
