The results are in!

Here are some facts about the participation and process of deciding the winners.

The jury: Ajay Rai, Joachim Sölva, Hanna Piepenburg, Christian and Kathy Hausmann

We received 47 entries from 7 countries - Albania(26), UK(7), Russia(6), Germany(3), Spain(2), Portugal(2) and Ireland(1).

Each jurist watched all films individually and gave points from 0 to 5 based on the following criterion:
