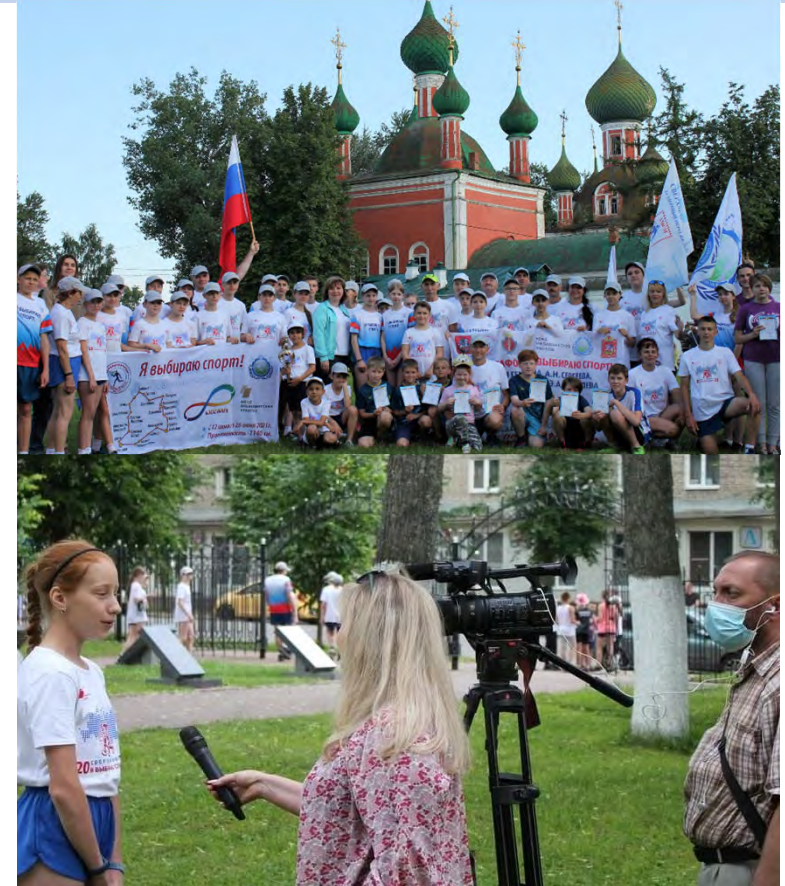

Russian Super Marathon Peace Road 12-26 June



On 12th June a Supermarathon Peace Road of 1,000 kilometres began in central Moscow. With a grant from the Presidential Fund for logistical support and help from the Ministry of the Interior in the form of police protection, the runners passed through the Golden Ring cities surrounding Moscow. Along the way they were welcomed in these ancient Russian holy cities by local political and religious leaders and other public figures. The event was covered widely by local media. The event concluded in Moscow on 26th June.

Russian 2nd Generation (12-13yo) 7-Day Workshop - 17-23 June



From 17 - 23 of June, 40 Second Generation children aged 12 and 13 from numerous cities in Russia attended a 7-day workshop in a facility in the Vladimir Region, located around 2 hours from Moscow. It consisted of Divine Principle lectures, sports, creative family evenings, prayer and meditation and even the experience of baking their own bread.
