

Approximately 800 viewers in 11 time zones viewed the Eastern Europe sub-regional Sunday service on December 26. Emcees Gani and Marjeta Rroshi from Albania introduced EUME President Dr. Michael Balcomb, who offered a recorded message of greeting. Eastern Europe President Jack Corley gave the main message, explaining the role of True Mother in the current providence. Throughout the program, members gave moving testimonies concerning various accomplishments – becoming CheonBo victors, doing Ancestor Liberation and Blessing, witnessing, and distributing True Parents' autobiographies. 
