



LAUNCH OF THE CIG PEACE EMBASSY IN TIRANA

The first Cheon Il Guk Peace Embassy in the World Opens in Shin Albania

The grand opening for the CheonIlGuk Peace Embassy in Tirana, Albania took place on Sunday, November 21st. The ribbon cutting was attended by five former Presidents and Prime Ministers from Albania, Montenegro, Croatia Kosovo and Bosnia & Herzegovina and several hundred local Ambassadors for Peace. FFWPU and UPF leaders from all over Europe were in attendance.

The keynote speaker was the Mayor of Tirana, Elion Veliaj, who spoke both in Albanian and flawless English. He said he was proud to see the Peace Embassy built so quickly, and just in time because next year Tirana will be the European City of Youth. This will be a great opportunity for to develop the work of Youth and Service for Peace in partnership with the city, and the new CheonIlGuk Embassy will be a central place for education. Veliaj immediately posted a 7-minute video on his social media account which has already been seen all over Albania. “There are many Embassies in Tirana,” he said “but I think that this one, the Embassy of Peace, is the most important of all.”

“This Peace Embassy is a precious gift from God,” FFWPU Albania President Mrs. Manjola Vasmatics, who served as MC for the





program. “It is not just for us, but for all the people of Albania and the Balkans.” Several other speakers echoed this sentiment, including UPF Balkans chair President Alfred Moisiu. True Mother sent a special message for the occasion which was presented on her behalf by Dr. Balcomb.

“I am convinced that the nations of the Balkans, which have suffered so much in recent generations, have a great destiny, to be a model of peace and cooperation that the whole world can follow,” she said. “Here is my own homeland I am working to bring about the long-delayed peaceful reunification of the Korean peninsula as a Heavenly Unified Korea. Peace is never an easy task, however, because it always means that we must live for the sake of others more than we live for our own selves. “But, I know you can do it. I have been inspired by the energy and courage of the Albanian people ever since I first visited the country in 2000 and again in 2005 with my late husband, the Rev. Sun Myung Moon. It is my lifelong goal to see all the nations of the world join together in loving cooperation so that we may at last become true brothers and sisters, one family under God.”

The Peace Embassy, which is our first purpose-built building in Europe, ex-

tends over seven floors from the sub-basement parking all the way up to the roof terrace with spectacular views of Tirana and the mountains surrounding the city. There is a state-of-the-art auditorium for 250 people, smaller conference rooms, offices, rooms for children and a kitchen and café. The upper four floors will be rented out to high level tenants and already several embassies have made inquiries.

The Peace Embassy is truly beautiful both inside and outside. We have some very nice trees and plants around the Embassy, and pride of place goes to two fine Magnolia Trees representing True Parents which stand guard over the entrance. Then there are five healthy olive trees and many other bushes and flowers. It all makes for a beautiful contrast with the glass and ceramic of the building’s modern exterior, a good balance of yin and yang.

Despite earthquakes, the Covid-19 pandemic and many other obstacles, the ceremony took place just 755 days after the ground-breaking ceremony on October 28, 2019. Still, there were many difficulties along the way. “Behind the scenes, it was a spiritual battle,” said Dr. Balcomb, who oversaw the project in his capacity as the Regional President of FFWPU Europe and the Middle

East, “There was plenty of drama up to the last minute. Two days before the ceremony, a water tank on the roof burst just as night was falling. Luckily, we happened to be on the roof terrace for prayer and we noticed immediately and were able to call the engineers before too much damage was done.”

Project Director Gani Rroshi, the President of UPF Albania who guided the project on a daily basis agreed. “At the consecration and holy salting ceremony the day before the opening, there was a power spike in the neighbourhood and electrical power was lost for several hours. It seemed impossible that everything could be ready on time,” he said. “Despite the challenges, the construction team found way to keep going right up to the last minute, and the final result is wonderful.”



Peace Road 2021 – Across the entire country from West to East, along Hadrian’s Wall



After 300,000 steps, 154 kilometres and the equivalent of 600 stories of stairs, Peace Road UK was completed as the team travelled across the entire country from west to east, along Hadrian’s Wall. This report was filed on the final day:

“Fumiko and I and all the UK Peace Road team send our warm greetings from the city of Newcastle in the north-east of England. Together with many brothers and sisters, we have now safely completed the Peace Road UK 2021.

It was an amazing experience over the last eight days, as we walked across the entire country from west to east, following Hadrian’s wall.

Even though we both normally walk 10000 steps every day, this was very different, and frankly all of us wondered whether we could really make it! But thanks to Heavenly Parent’s protection and True Mother’s prayers we made it without any injury or accident.

We weren’t the only ones walking the Wall, and we met many friendly and determined people walking across the country in both directions for a variety of reasons. One particularly moving encounter was with a father, his son, and a friend. The father was totally blind, and held onto a rope attached to his friend’s backpack. Meanwhile, the 9-year old son proudly walked in front. Suddenly, my sore feet didn’t feel quite so sore!

Our own youngest walker was 15, and our eldest over 80. For all of us, it was an incredibly moving experience combining our utmost physical efforts with a deep spiritual purpose. As we walked, we often thought about True Parents, and how they walked as refugees from North Korea to South Korea so many years ago. Now of course we are hoping that we will soon be able to walk back from the south to the north, across the 38th parallel and visit our True Parents hometowns of Anju and Cheonju.

When that day comes we would like to walk it as a pilgrimage, not travel by car!

Saturday August 7th was our last day of walking, one week after we left Bowness, and we were happy to be welcomed by the Lord Mayor of Newcastle, Habib Rahman. Mayor Rahman is still in his 40s and as a Muslim man in a city where there are not so many Muslims has had to overcome many prejudices. He spoke encouragingly about the work of UPF and asked us to invite him to our future programs. Then he walked with us through his own city for a couple of miles, posing to take photographs at some of the bridges for which Newcastle is famous. We were also joined by the Mayor of Carlisle, Pam Birks, our first city, so we feel hopeful that this event is raising True Parents’ and our movement’s public profile.“



HADRIAN'S WALL

also known as the Roman Wall, is a former defensive fortification of the Roman province of Britannia, begun in AD 122 in the reign of the emperor Hadrian. Running from Wallsend on the River Tyne in the east to Bowness-on-Solway in the west, the Wall covered the whole width of the island.

A significant portion of the wall still stands and can be followed on foot along the adjoining Hadrian's Wall Path. The largest Roman archaeological feature in Britain, it runs a total of 73 miles (117.5 kilometres) in northern England. Regarded as a British cultural icon, Hadrian's Wall is one of Britain's major ancient tourist attractions. It was designated as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1987.

Peace Road 2021

The Peace Road was held on September 18th, the anniversary of the Washington Monument rally. This year our event was held in Tuusula which is a historic place in Finland. During the golden age of Finnish art, the best-known artists settled there. The artists developed and reinforced Finland's culture and self-esteem during politically difficult times when Finland was a part of the Russian empire.

To start the Peace Road event, people gathered in front of a statue of Sibelius, after which nine people went around Lake Tuusula(26km) by bicycle or electric scooter. While the cyclists went around the lake, others

visited museums that were originally artists' homes.

The cyclists made a pit stop at the Lotta museum to listen to the story of the Lotta SVÄRD association. The museum exhibits the history of the Lotta SVÄRD association and studies the volunteer work of women. In the early 1920s, the Lotta SVÄRD association organized at the national level and developed into a women's voluntary civil defense organization with social significance. The association did versatile relief and aid work for both the Finnish defense forces and the civilian population. At best, the association had 240,000 members, including around 50,000 Junior Lottas between the ages of 8 and 17.

After visiting the Lotta museum, the cyclists stopped at the Lutheran church to meet the head pastor, Ms.

Ulla Rosenqvist. She was very happy to welcome the cyclists and bless them with a prayer about peace.

Afterwards, the cyclists continued to go around the lake and reach the end goal where supporters and volunteers were enthusiastically waiting for them.

At the end, everybody could enjoy each other's company with wonderful refreshments prepared by the volunteers and supporters. Some local people were also very curious and asked us about our program.

All in all, we feel that the Peace Road program helped us connect with TPs' heart & vision and spirit of Finnish artists in early 1900's.

Norwegian Webinar Series on Korea

As there is a strong focus on supporting the peace process in Korea we have organised a series of webinars towards this goal during this year. Since Norway and Scandinavia are far from Korea, our first webinar had the title «How can Scandinavia contribute to peace and development on the Korean peninsula?»

We managed to get a top scholar from each of our nations to participate. The Swedish speaker was the director of Institute for Security and Development Policy, ISDP. He has since then taken part in several other events. The Norwegian speaker was the former Director of Peace Research Institute Oslo, PRIO. He has also followed our events with interest.

In the European ILC in April we could have our former Norwegian Prime Minister, Kjell Magne Bondevik, as a speaker. Mr. Bondevik has been in Korea several times and was a friend of the former South Korean president Kim Dae-jung.

EXPERTS ON THE FIELD

We were able to connect to top Scandinavian experts on Korea. The webinar series was a great opportunity to invite them and listen to their evaluation.

In July we organised a webinar about humanitarian aid to North Korea. The Norwegian Red Cross representative gave a good report of their projects, together with the Director of The Evangelical Orient Misson. Both of them are interested to contribute more.

On the European ILC in August a Norwegian Asia expert and author gave his perspective on the obstacles and possibilities for a peaceful development in Korea.

Through this webinar series, as well as with follow-up of the participants, we have managed to gather a group of top Korea experts in our country to take part in our initiative. I believe they will be of good support in the peace process and also good friends and supporters of UPF.

Family Weekend Workshop

From the 30th July to the 1st August the Norwegian FFWPU organised a Family Weekend Workshop. After a long period with many online meetings it was a good experience to meet physically in person again. Around 30 members, young and old, participated.

The venue was located half an hour's walk into the forest, and to carry all the equipment for the weekend was already a good exercise in cooperation. The environment was beautiful with no disturbances from the outside society.

The whole program was entirely organised by a cooperation of 2nd generation families.

The program consisted of a combination of a spiritual and a social side. There was a Hoon Dok Hae every new

morning, some Divine Principle presentations and Sunday Service. A major part of the programme was the social aspect with competitions, games and sports. The family evenings were great with a never-ending series of songs that lifted the spirit "above the ceiling".

The round of reflections the last day was great: Our oldest participant of nearly 80 years old called it the best workshop ever. One of the children that was asked about the best part of the programme, answered surprisingly: the Hoon Dok Hae.

However, the weekend workshop offered something for everyone, created a good bond among us all, and stands as a highlight of our community events in 2021

Peace Road in Derry



In 2021, we focused on starting up activities online as it became obvious the 2020 lockdowns would probably continue. We started a few different recurring Zoom events.

The first was for our young 2nd and 1st generation, which we called Horizontal and Vertical Youth Nights. Every other week we had someone different present a horizontal activity, which ranged from doing some exercising together to a quiz game with prizes. Everyone had fun and it was great to be doing something together as a community again. The weeks in between we had a vertical focused session, either HDH or lecture practice.

The other event we organised digitally was a Cyber-Faith Round Table, which was focused on bringing together our UPF Ambassadors for Peace to discuss interesting topics related to

their work or something they were inspired to discuss. We held six of these throughout 2021.

Our biggest event for 2021 was our Peace Road Walk & Forum 2021 in Derry, Northern Ireland, organised by UPF Ireland and helped by UPF-UK providing two powerful speakers to the forum. The symbolism of having a peace event in Derry was something that made an impact on all the participants. We were honoured by a visit from the Mayor of Derry City, Alderman Graham Warke, who addressed the audience and took pictures with us. Overall, each speaker was excellent and passionate in their desire for peace and sharing their personal experience, and each was appointed as a new Ambassador for Peace as part of the event.

Creating the vision with an action plan



ICELAND

Our Highlight of 2021

The highlight of this year for Iceland was the publishing of the auto-biography of True Mother. It was a historic undertaking, same as the publishing of the autobiography of True Father in 2011.

We could go already paved ways of the past that helped to ensure the best quality available.

In publishing, the administrations tried to copy and surpass the accuracy of sincerity of bible translations throughout the centuries that caused major changes in medieval society and led ultimately to the emergence of the modern world.

I am especially thankful to the international translator's team that could trace mistakes filling eight pages (A4) of the initial English translation.

The mistakes ranged from the wrong place of True Mother's parents wedding hall to a wrong Danish princess etc.

Our translator was a carefully selected lady who already had worked on the previous autobiography. The translation then was inspected by competent language skilled members in Iceland and the US. Then a professional proof reader helped to ensure the correct spelling.

We are very grateful for four Peace Ambassadors writing their heartfelt tribute in the preface.

The layout was done by me and one Icelandic member. Both of us have a professional background in graphic



design. Finally the book went into digital printing.

We decided to keep the original subtitle "...Who wipes away the tears of mankind", and the term 'autobiography'.

There are several reasons for this:

1) The intention of the author


2) In relation to the content. The chosen subtitle of the English edition is nowhere to be found in the book, whereas the original is very well found and explained. The argument, people would not read a book

with such a bold statement is in contradiction to successful marketing that indeed lives on controversy. A similar case can be found in True Father's autobiography, where in the original translation Father's comment on war, oil, money in relation to the Iraq war was erased and not to be found in the English version. It is however in the Korean, Japanese and Icelandic version. Again the argument to not offend the American government falls short, since True Parents proclaimed publicly the peace messages for many years and clearly pointing to the same content.

3) By definition, a Memoir is an author's memory written down. An autobiography can have external contributors to supplement and strengthen the content.

In conclusion, being part of such an historic undertaking as the translation of the autobiographies of True Parents is an honour of unimaginable significance that will remain for all eternity on this earth.

The whole team was moving while keeping our precious beloved True Mother in our hearts and sending this as our nation's gift of gratitude for the occasion.


- The exhibition was the most beautiful experience I had with Heavenly Parent, with people and our team members. I will never forget it, because of what I learned.

ARMENIA

Strengthening our local structure

October 16 brought us together in the beautiful city of Gjakova, in the activity organized by the Peace Council of the Gjakova Region "Promotion of the Principles of Universal Peace Federation". The event was attended by 25 Ambassadors of Peace, intellectuals and honored persons from the city of Gjakova, Malisheva and Rahovec.

We introduced the participants to the Principles of the Universal Peace Federation and the meaning and value of the title of "Ambassador for Peace".

16 prominent and respected personalities of the city of Gjakova in the fields of Art, Culture, Education, Medicine, Engineering, Journalism and Politics became part of the UPF family.

RUSSIA

The Kolsky program

traditionally is organized in July for 16- and 17-year-olds to deeply understand Divine Principle and True Parents' life and put this knowledge into practice. This time twenty young people from all over Russia came to St. Petersburg to find God, study the truth and challenge themselves to do fundraising. In the second part of the program, they went to the Lapland Nature Reserve for service projects such as building eco-trails and constructing tourist buildings. It is a great way to practice living for others and overcoming limitations.

“Lapland – the Growth Point”

is a youth forum to which YSP brought young NGO leaders and student-volunteers from prominent Moscow universities. The diverse program included Peace Designer training in which participants created their own projects and meaningful talks by very interesting speakers. Many participants called the youth forum very precise, practical and clear, and said that all the action steps and schedule were understandable. The participants created two new projects from scratch. While enjoying the beauty of nature, they constructed a 230-meter eco-walking trail.

The 21-day workshop,

a cornerstone of our education system, this year took place in August in St. Petersburg with 19 participants from Moscow, St. Petersburg, Voronezh, Yekaterinburg, Ufa, Kalin-



ingrad. The students studied Divine Principle and True Parents' lives in depth, took part in discussions, got in touch with their inner original self and discovered God's word in their lives. The program included sightseeing, games and other youth activities.

Three-month training

This year we began a special three-month training program in which young people take time off from work or study to invest in their life of faith, building strong relationships with Heavenly Parent and True Parents through fundraising, witnessing, studying Divine Principle and learning to give lectures. The first three-month program started on 25 June and finished on 23 September.

There were two 1st generation participants and two 2nd generation participants. After the project the participants also had a meeting with the school administration and students.



The event was filmed and highlighted by local and Kyiv mass media, with a livestream from the venue.


During the celebration of the national midsummer holiday Ligo, FFWPU representatives visited the Vaishnav (Hindu) community and gave the Blessing to two couples.





Three new issues in 2021

The theme of this first issue of 2021 is “Reconciliation between the Two Koreas.” Among the articles on this theme are reports from two webinars conducted by UPF of Russia about the reunification of North and South Korea; an analysis by journalist and Korea expert Michael Breen of the relationship between the two Koreas; and an explanation of the UPF founders’ vision for Korean reunification written by Jacques Marion, the regional co-chair of UPF for Europe, Eurasia and the Middle East.

The second issue for 2021 addresses such important topics as the Think Tank 2022 launch that occurred on May 9 during the sixth Rally of Hope. More than 2,000 experts confirmed the new peace initiative.

A second major event was a webinar on the family, held jointly by Universal Peace Federation and Women’s Federation for World Peace on May 14 in celebration of the International Day of Families established by the United Nations. Four speakers, all university professors, spoke on the theme “Which Family ... Toward Which Future?” The webinar was very well attended.

Another important webinar, which took place on March 2, presented a book on North Korea and its prospects for change. The author, an Italian journalist who spent some time in North Korea, gives a very interesting cross-section of that nation for us to study.

This third issue of 2021 delves into international issues mainly related to the Asian area: Afghanistan, Myanmar (former Burma) and the Korean Peninsula, with a particular focus on the Asian Northeast. What prospects for peace are there for the Asian continent?

In addition, the contribution that faiths can make to our mental and physical health in the time of the Pandemic from Covid is examined by religious leaders.




Run for Peace

In his speech he also recalled the most important initiatives of UPF: the “Summit 2020”, attended by 6000 delegates from 170 countries, the “International Leadership Conferences” (ILC), the “Rally of Hope”, now in its seventh edition, and the “Think Tank 2022” project, a global and multi-sectoral network of over two thousand experts from different disciplines, committed to finding solutions to the most complex problems of our time.

The event, promoted to celebrate the “International Day of Peace” established by the United Nations, was organized by Universal Peace Federation (UPF-Italy), in collaboration with the International Media Association for Peace (IMAP-Italy), the International Association of Academics for Peace (IAAP-Italy), the Women's Federation for World Peace (WFWP-Italy) and Eco dai Palazzi.





TRUE MOTHER'S MEMOIR INTRODUCED AT THE INTERNATIONAL BOOKFAIR IN FRANKFURT

KANDO Publishers with the support of the EUME Headquarters presented a variety of books about True Parents' vision, life, and teachings to an international audience.

After a one-year break, the Frankfurt Book Fair (Frankfurter Buchmesse) took place again from October 20th to 24th, 2021 under certain COVID restrictions (limited number of exhibitors and visitors, social distance rules, mask requirement, etc.). This year's focus of the KANDO publishing house was the first presentation of the memoirs of Dr. Hak Ja Han Moon - *Mother of Peace* - in more than 10 languages. In the Czech Republic, one of the highlights of the year 2021 was definitely a Service Project in town called Mikulčice. This event took place on 15th and 16th October 2021, and it was organized as a cooperation of our UPF chapter with Czech and Slovak YSP. Tornadoes and similar phenomena normally do not pose any threat in our part of the world. However, this time it did not only appear, but also it destroyed the area and even killed a few people. With a young spirit and spirit of empathy and solidarity the volunteers did all kinds of work. Carrying heavy concrete panels, cleaning, mixing concrete and many other things. The participants were greeted by the mayor of the village who appreciated their help and determination to work in the humble conditions that the village could offer.

It is important to say that this event that had full support of the local mayor, was organized based on previous two successful Peace Road events:

On Sunday, 20th of June, due to the cooperation of Universal Peace Federation Germany, Austria and the Czech Republic this Peace Road became a deep experience for almost 100 participants. On occasion of the Day of Refugees participants from 3 nations joined in a common meeting at the hill of Trojmezí where the three nations have a common border. At the top the participants could meet bringing their national flags around a monument pointing the border and the European anthem was sung. Czech UPF president reminded that the existence of communism and democracy divided our nations for 40 years. The hatred had been more or less overcome, and all these countries started anew. Yet still there is one country and one nation in the world which remains to be divided by ideology. It is the Korean peninsula. The 38th parallel still divides

the country and is a borderline between communism and democracy. We hope that one day soon also the Korean people can meet and be united once again.

On Sunday, 29th August 2021, the Czech and Slovak UPF chapters as the main organizers convened a Peace Road on the common border. The participants met on the bridge that connects both countries in a beautiful scenery of nature. The main speakers of the event were presidents of a UPF chapter in Czech and Slovakia, Juraj Lajda and Milos Klas, mayor of Mikulcice town Josef Dvoracek, mayor of Dolní Bojanovice village Eva Rajchmanová and evangelical pastor Mikulas Vymetal, as well as many other including a Korean native sister who pointed out once more, about the ongoing division on the Korean peninsula.

Based on this event and based on establishing a good contact with the Mikulcice mayor Josef Dvoracek, the above-mentioned Service Project took place.



BELGIUM

A Road to Reconciliation and a Hope for War No More

On Sunday 1st August 2021, we held our Peace Road in Belgium. As we know, the Peace Road initiative is built around the theme: “Connecting the World: A Road to Reconciliation and a Hope for War no More”.

Famously, the main battlefield of the 1st World War was on Belgian soil around the beautiful city of Ypres which was identically and meticulously reconstructed after the war ended. Consequently, in the vicinity of Ypres numerous war cemeteries of the nations involved can be found. Our intention was that by visiting the major war cemeteries of the nations who took part in the 1st World War, we would be symbolically connecting both allied and enemy countries in a spirit of reconciliation. With this spirit of ‘loving your

enemies’ and also ‘loving your own’ we started out with a visit to Germany's largest and most significant war cemetery (45,000 soldiers) followed by the Belgian, Canadian, British Commonwealth and French ones. We concluded our journey in Ypres at the well-known Menin Gate which is a huge Commonwealth war monument whereupon are engraved the 55,000 names of all the Commonwealth soldiers whose bodies have never been found or identified.

Remarkably, since 1927, every evening at 8 pm, people still gather at this Gate for a solemn rendition of ‘The Last Post’ in memory of the war dead. Our Peace Road World War One cemeteries tour experience left a deep impression on all participants, 21 Belgians and 4 French. Yves Leterme, former Prime

Minister of Belgium, sent a message that he would have liked to participate together, but he had a personal impediment. Deep prayers were offered at each site, and several of our brothers and sisters expressed that they felt as if the soldiers who were buried there had been waiting for us since a long time to be included in True Parent’s process of liberation and resurrection from their resentments and miserable suffering. Perhaps appropriately, it was raining a lot during the day (which helped us to remember and appreciate the soldier’s realistic conditions). However, we noticed that every time we paused for a group picture the rain suddenly stopped only to resume soon thereafter. This reassured us that God was giving His blessing upon our event.





International Leadership Conferences 2021

In April, June, July and August 2021, UPF and its constituent associations hosted a series of virtual conferences on peace and reunification of the Korean Peninsula, each addressing the theme from a different perspective. UPF Europe & Middle East (EUME) hosted a total of 34 webinars, attended by thousands of participants.

The **ILC in April** focused on “The Foundation for a Unified World”. One of the eight webinars was organized by the International Summit Council for Peace and questioned “The Implications for Europe”. It was moderated by Dr. Werner Fasslabend, former Austrian minister of defense, and hosted as keynote speakers H.E. Kjell Magne Bondevik, former PM of

Norway, H.E. Yves Leterme, former PM of Belgium, Dr. Karin Kneissl, former foreign minister of Austria, and Dr. Alexander Zhebin, Institute of Far Eastern Studies, Russian Academy of Sciences.

The first of seven webinars that took place during the **June ILC** focusing on “Peace and Security”, had as keynote speaker Major General Patrick Gauchat, head of the Swiss delegation to the Neutral Nations Supervisory Commission (NNSC), who spoke of their peacekeeping mission and the role of neutral nations.

The **July ILC** on “Best Practices in Track II Diplomacy” consisted of eight webinars, out of which one was organized by WFWP and IAFLP, focusing on “The Emerging Power of Women’s Diplomacy”, and had as major speak-

ers former first lady and former minister of Social Affairs of Lebanon, H.E. Nayla Moawad, and H.E. Neziha Labidi, former minister for Women, Family, Children and Senior Citizens from Tunisia. Another session hosted by IAYSP EUME questioned the role of young people in contributing to peace in Korea.

The **August ILC** on “Economic Development and Worldviews”, had one webinar co-hosted with UPF North America, on the topic of “Competing Worldviews Concerning Korean Reunification” with researchers and journalists as speakers. Another session focused on the “Korea-Japan Undersea Tunnel” and had as one of the main speakers Prof. Jin-Hee Park, from the Korean Maritime and Oceanic University in South Korea.

Balkans Leadership Conference

Memorandum of Cooperation

During the Balkans Leadership Conference in Tirana, Albania, on November 20-21, 2021, a Memorandum of Cooperation was signed between UPF EUME and the Podgorica Club, an organization founded in 2019 by former Presidents of the governments and states of the Southeast European region. The conference was attended by six former heads of state and governments and 120 Peace Ambassadors from the Balkans Region, as well as by UPF representatives from 25 nations.

Inauguration of the Peace Embassy

The conference concluded with the Inauguration of the Balkans Peace Embassy; a building dedicated to promoting peace in the Balkans region that will serve as a regional UPF headquarters. Initiated with a groundbreaking ceremony at the time of UPF's Southeast Europe Peace Summit in Tirana in October 2019, the building was inaugurated in the presence of the mayor of Tirana and the six former heads of state and governments of the Balkans region.


WFWPI and Public Leadership

This year great advances have been made in reaching positions of public leadership and recognition. More and more WFWP leaders are being invited as expert speakers, to radio talk shows, and being elected in public office. WFWP EU President was unanimously elected President of the UN NGO Committee on the Status of Women in Geneva. WFWPI UN Office Director in Vienna was elected Chair of the Peace Committee.

WFWP and Education

WFWP EUME has published its new curriculum, now being launched in 20 locations and translated into 3 languages. It was tested in 2 university seminars with over 20 university students in Germany. "A World of Peace a Woman's Way". This long effort over 6 years, has been contrib-

uted to by many, including youth. There are plans to use it in refugee camps as well.



Global Women's Peace Network

Women's Leadership: WFWP has hosted many dozens of virtual seminars, touching hundreds of lives, women, men and youth. Skills training, awareness raising, solidarity-building on issues related to peace and conflict resolution, women in political leadership, community cohesion and migration, women of faith, youth empowerment, support for the SDG's. Dialogues brought leaders together with civil society for Afghanistan, Lebanon, parliamentarians together with communities. As co hosts for the International Association of First Ladies for Peace (IAFLP), WFWP organised 4 large events reaching thousands of views that highlighted the valuable role of women's mentor-like, motherly leadership in rallying populations and bringing lasting solutions, and leading by example.

Most WFWP chapters have youth in leadership roles. Young Women Speech Contest s, initiated in the UK, are now being held in other nations, becoming an annual tradition under the WFWP EU Women's Peace Academy. A WFWP UN Office and ME joint event brought in youth from throughout the world, including Palestine and Israel, to work out an Israel/ Palestine Peace Accord.

A similar event will be held in 2022 on the Korean Peninsula. Internships are being held triannually at our UN Offices in Geneva and Vienna the area of Human Rights and Crime Prevention.



YOUTH AND STUDENTS FOR PEACE

In 2021 young people in our region were seriously affected by conflicts in the Middle East as well as the COVID 19 pandemic and its sociopsychological and economic implications. In this period IAYSP Europe and the Middle East, with its empowering message, could reach a total of 18,679 people through 99 events conducted both on and offline. Chapters mobilized young people for service projects such as trash collecting, building eco-parks, or distributing hygienic kits.

A regional Youth Forum titled **“RISE TOGETHER – Surviving the Pandemic and Staying Sane”** was held online. A panel of mental health experts discussing the effects of the lockdown on young people, answering questions from the audience, and introducing solutions and tools necessary to overcome these difficult times.

Other **Youth Peace Talks** on topics such as “UN in peacekeeping”, “Volunteering in the Sociocultural Sphere” and “The role of youth in the UN sustainable development agenda” reached young

MPs, students, activists and other VIPs.

To draw attention to the situation on the Korean Peninsula, a youth forum was held titled: **“Imagining a Unified World: The Youth’s Contribution to Peace on the Korean Peninsula”?** as well as Korean cultural evenings.

To celebrate the **International Day of Happiness**, IAYSP EUME organised a regional online Youth Rally titled “RISE to Happiness”. Participants saw how youth across Europe and the Middle East contributed in small and big ways - through Responsibility, Integrity, Service, and Empathy - to others’ and their own well-being and happiness.

We held a Youth Heroes’ Award Ceremony to celebrate the seven newly appointed Youth Heroes across the region. 13 Peace Designer Training workshops were held, collaborating with four schools, with a total of 124 graduates. A team of young educators could develop a more in depth syllabus to upgrade this programme and make it more appealing.

The HJ Youth Academy

In response to the unprecedented challenges of the last 2 years, the Europe and Middle East region has adapted with new programmes. True Mother continues to share a powerful message of hope, and raising young people is one of her key strategic priorities. The HJ Youth Academy has been established in response to True Mother's hopes.

First online programme: Foundations

The HJ Youth Academy was officially launched on October 15th with its first online programme: Foundations, a 40-day course on spiritual leadership for young people and young leaders aged 18-39. The HJ Youth Academy aims to provide education, training,

and support for current and future young leaders, so that they may effectively serve God's Providence led by True Parents and build the Heavenly Parent's Holy Community. The Academy's first programme, Foundations took place online between 15th October and 23rd November, 2021. Over 12 sessions delivered twice a week, participants could receive education relevant for spiritual growth. This included world-class speakers from our global Unification family, regular assignments after each session, an option to join a daily hoon dok hwe group, and a space for genuine fellowship with others across the EUME region. The programme could bring together 72 participants from all over the region, with certain participants joining from Korea and USA.

Nordic programs 2021

Throughout the year a group of young 2nd gen took the initiative in organizing online workshops and monthly sessions to guide youth throughout the pandemic. The sessions were on various topics but all related to the present guidance of our True Mother about the culture of Hyo Jeong. The invited speakers were sharing their testimonies with True Parents and their understanding of the providence. Altogether 493 participants joined 8 programs.

ODP+ Workshop

The ESGD organized variety of workshops in 2021 both online and in person with more than 500 brothers and sisters joining throughout the year. One of the memorable online experience was the Easter workshop. Many of us attending it could experience a special connectedness beyond a mere zoom link. There was an unexpected magic in certain moments which could bring us beneath the surface of day-to-day life. The sharing platter of lecturers and topics provided good food for thought on the theme of why “We are not going to Mars!” (how to remain grounded in the Principle and spirituality). We explored words of truth and poetry, wisdom and philosophy, interwoven with personal reflections and stories.

“What stayed in my mind was the question if I want to be a well-protected individual or if I want to become a strong person” (Earthling 26, participant)

The highlight for all workshop lovers was the summer when we could offer two European workshops in person: Senior HARP and ODP+ WS. With the motto “Soul Identity” we wanted to create a space for soul-searching, connection, and re-evaluation; that will help us discover our soul identity.

We are grateful we could run DONE 021 in person with participants and staff from Europe, America and Canada. There was a variety of lecturers and education, focused on studying the Divine Principle and how to apply the wisdom in our daily lives as well as dedicating the final week to Matching and Blessing content. A highlight of this year’s programme was a trip to the mountains, which gave a unique opportunity for contemplation and inner connectedness with God. We started the second module in mid-November; it will run online until Christmas. DONE 021 journey will continue in 2022.

Our special thanks go to all educators, staff of all workshops and DONE programme who supported participants and contributed to significant experience for their lives. We thank to all donors for their kind help. We thank all participants for investing into their growth and spiritual life, and their commitment into growing a deeper relationship with God and True Parents. Throughout programmes we were reminded of our potential, linked to our identity and our roots. We believe each one of us has an important role to contribute to The Holy Community of Blessed families.

Meaningful Highlights of 2021

From January to June, we supported local CARP chapters during Covid restrictions by organizing monthly public lectures online on various topics. The attendance was an average of 60 people.

In January, around 30 young people attended **workshop “Learning, how to teach the Divine Principle”** over several weeks and learned how to become Divine Principle lecturers.

Regular **online Divine Principle lecture series** were organized for guests. A total of 457 participants took part in four different lecture series that took place from January to June 2021.

In summer, the Witnessing Department organized an **online 14 Day Divine Principle Workshop** with two lectures every day from some of our best lecturers in the EUME Region. We had over 500 registrations. In Nigeria, they organized a physical workshop for 50 participants, and they were viewing

our workshop live over the internet. The clergy and community leaders were very impressed with the presentations, and all of them received a certificate of attendance.

More Divine Principle workshops took place physically mixing guests and 2nd Generation youth throughout the region in Albania, Romania, Ukraine, Russia and other countries.

A **new Divine Principle Online Study website** was created in October 2021. So far over 120 signed up for the Divine Principle course on the website. www.divineprinciplestudy.org

Young missionaries were dispatched to our region - thirteen already came to Albania from the USA. In the beginning of 2022, six CIG Missionaries from GPA came to Romania and fourteen to Albania. More missionaries should be coming from Korea and the EUME Hyojeong Academy in 2022.

Finally, we are **helping communities** in outreach for Tribal Messiahship activities. During the year, we held several meetings with communities to help them to increase their Cheonbo Victors and find ways to educate 43 couples. In the last CB Festival, the EUME Region reached 452 Cheonbo Victors.

Upcoming Activities in 2022

The Witnessing Department will continue helping communities to multiply their Cheonbo couples and in the education of 43 and the development of Family Values events (FFWPU). The department will support missionary programs (education and outreach to youth) and will create new online programs and a youth community platform. Finally, if the external circumstances allow it, we will hold the 15 Day Divine Principle Workshop in July in Gafelnz, Austria.


