Over the past weekend, our National Director couple visited the new young community in Warsaw who promote co-living together.

After attending the Blessing and Matching workshop in Glanow, Poland, Fumiko and I went on to Warsaw. Together with FFWPU Poland leaders, Kristoff and Martha Kral, we wanted to meet up with the exciting new witnessing team led by a group of young Ukrainians. They came to Poland just a couple of weeks before the war in Ukraine began and have stayed in Warsaw ever since, bringing a lot of youthful energy to our Peace Embassy.





Team leader Vlad explained that the team goes out on campus and in the downtown area almost every day. They found it difficult to invite people to come directly to the Peace Embassy or our new downtown witnessing center - everyone is busy, and a little suspicious. So instead they hold discussions in local coffee shops and then invite their new friends to do a little study online through the website or social media channels. Those who do so can then be recontacted and invited to a cultural evening or a one-day seminar. After that, those who want to go further have the opportunity to move into the Peace Embassy.



"We are promoting the idea of co-living," said Vlad, "and already a number of young Poles have joined our community, and one has made a full one-year commitment to join our activities."

Fumiko and I were impressed that, even though their homeland is suffering so much, the team has devoted themselves so well to the higher calling of sharing about the truth and love of God. And we felt that we could try a similar approach for our own co-living community at Livingstone House.
