True Parents' Holy Wedding

-- Friday, February 22, 2013 (1.13 by the Heavenly calendar in the 4th year of Cheon-gi), Cheongshim Peace World Center, Chung Pyung

Blessing Ceremony for New Couples

-- Sunday, February 17, 2012 (1.8 by the Heavenly calendar in the 4th year of Cheon-gi), Cheongshim Peace World Center, Chung Pyung

-- Expected participants: (1) single 1st generation matched candidates and single 2nd generation candidates matched by their parents, (2) matched candidates qualified for the Cheon Il Guk standard matching, (3) previously-married couples (including those with one partner in the Spiritual World)

-- Cheon Il Guk standard matching is expected to be held sometime from February 12-14, 2013 (1.3 - 1.5 by the heavenly calendar in the 4th year of Cheon-gi) at Cheon Jeong Gung according to True Parents' schedule.

-- Programs for brides and grooms will be held on February 16-17, 2013 (1.7 - 1.8 by the heavenly calendar in the 4th year of Cheon-gi) at Cheonga Camp and other accommodations.
