As you are aware, Parents' Day is a U.S. national observance, observed yearly on the 4th Sunday of July. Yearly, National Parents of the Year are recognized at a National Parents' Day award ceremony, to be held this year on July 25th, at 4:00 pm (virtual); co-sponsored by UPF, ACLC, and WFWP.

You are invited to submit nominations for National Parents of the Year 2021.

Nominations may be submitted at the National Parents Day website at: parentsday.com.

Deadline for submissions is July 9th.

Award Categories and Criteria for Parents of the Year 2021:

The four award categories this year are for:

- (1) National Parents of the Year (overall);
- (2) Faith Community National Parents of the Year;
- (3) National Parents of the Year for Outstanding Sacrifice;
- (4) National Parents of the Year as Civic Leaders.

Do not be concerned too much about which category they will fit into. The judges will make the final decision on that, although you are free to give your recommendation.

Criteria for Parents' Day award nominees:

1. Exemplify qualities of sacrificial love.
2. Have overcome major obstacles (emotional, physical, financial, etc.) to provide for the personal development and happiness of children.
3. Exhibit qualities of personal moral virtue and/or religious commitment.
4. Have a noteworthy record of contributions to the family in the larger community.

Outreach and community support:

You may invite Ambassadors for Peace, ACLC Clergy, civic and community leaders to nominate National Parents of the Year. This is a good opportunity for community engagement and provide support to ACLC Clergy churches, community leaders and civic leaders.

You may also nominate any Ambassadors for Peace, ACLC clergy, civic leaders couple or any outstanding couple for National Parents of the Year.
