On Wednesday evening, November 13, 2013, more than 300 people gathered in Elk Grove Village, IL at the Holiday Inn, to welcome Rev. Young Hwi Kim and his wife Mrs. Dae Wha Chung Kim, who were sent here on the direction of our True Mother as True Mother's representative.

Wednesday, being a mid-week day, created challenges for our members, but nevertheless, more than 12 states gathered - not only the Midwest states, but Texas, Nebraska, Oklahoma, Utah and so on. The energy of the audience was great as we prepared for the program with holy songs and prayer.

On Thursday, the next evening in Chicago, Rev. and Mrs. Young Hwi Kim gave the Chicago community another chance to spend special time together with them.

Rev. and Mrs. Kim joined a community fellowship meeting held at Allen and Ritsuko Davidson's family home, together with 50 local members, sharing their personal testimonies and valuable advice to the members intimately.

Rev. Kim testified about early church life in Korea with True Father and Mother and explained how many spiritual phenomena influenced them all. He also pointed out that understanding the Divine Principle correctly is very important to develop and sustain our religious motivation. Mrs. Kim also shared, in fluent Japanese, her life experiences of exemplary service to True Parents.

Beginning with her experience of offering to serve in the kitchen of the old headquarters church cooking for True Parents in 1960's. She was blessed to have such a precious role in caring for them as well as her own family. Because of that experience, which even to this day, she continues to practice by calling (even during this tour) the current kitchen staff of True Parents to make sure they are serving True Parents correctly and sincerely. Mrs. Kim also shared about how much True Father poured his heart out in the 1950's to take care of members individually and how the members felt loved and did not want to leave the church even after midnight.
