Young Hwi Kim Concludes 5 City Tour in New York City and Washington DC

More than 600 Unificationists from New Jersey, New York and Connecticut attended the second-to-last stop of Rev. Young Hwi Kim's five-city speaking tour in New York City.

Unificationists from the East Coast came out in the thousands to attend the last two-stops of respected elder Rev. Young Hwi Kim's speaking tour in New York City and Washington, D.C. on November 16 and 17, 2013. The following includes separate reports and participant impressions from the concluding events. Unificationists Excitedly Receive Rev. Kim in New York City

Rev. Young Hwi Kim, one of the most respected elders of the Unification Church, spoke to nearly 600 members in New York City on Saturday, Nov. 16, 2013, on the fourth stop of a five-city U.S. tour representing True Mother.

Members from New York, New Jersey, Massachusetts and Connecticut started lining up two hours before the 10:00 a.m. starting time to enter the Grand Ballroom of the New Yorker Hotel, the site of many historic events in our movement.



Rev. Kim looked energetic as he gave an inspiring speech in flawless English about True Father's life course and activities in the Spirit World.

Rev. Kim, looking energetic and healthy at age 85, gave an inspiring speech in flawless English, in which he walked us through True Father's entire life course, concluding with the work he is now doing in heaven. All of his points had implications for our life of faith. He made clear to us the significance of True Father's final words, what True Father has accomplished, the absolute unity of True Father and True Mother, and how blessed we are to have received True Parents' Blessing. Beyond that, he encouraged us to have conviction and to work to liberate the spiritual world as well as witness to those in our family and to those who are living all around us.

Rev. Kim's talk was preceded by a very powerful and inspiring video that portrayed True Mother's recent activities: her speaking tour in Japan, her efforts to raise up our future leaders, and her work to prepare True Father's words that they might shine as a diamond to the entire world.

The program was opened by a beautiful, heartfelt prayer from Denneze Neslon, representing the Women's Federation for World Peace (WFWP). Next, Dr. Neil Salonen, president of the University of Bridgeport, reminded us of the importance of God's word and the fact that it was Rev. Kim who had come to the United States with True Parents in 1972 in order to teach the Divine Principle to the American movement.

Dr. Ki Hoon Kim, the North American continental director, explained the significance of Rev. Kim's visit: Rev. Kim was sent to us by True Mother so that we might connect to her in heart and in action.





Dr. Michael Balcomb, president of FFWPU-USA, gave the closing call-to-action remarks, and Dr. Michael Jenkins, chairman of the American Clergy Leadership Conference, led everyone present in three cheers of Eok-Mansei.

United States' Capitol Marks Last Stop of Rev. Young Hwi Kim's Speaking Tour



At the last stop of Rev. Kim's speaking tour, almost 700 people came to listen to him recount True Parents' life and accomplishments in Washington, D.C.

The final presentation of President Young Hwi Kim's Five City tour to deliver an educational and encouraging message from our True Mother was powerfully presented at La Fontaine Bleue Banquet Hall, Lanham, Maryland on Sunday, Nov. 17.



The audience listened intently to Rev. Kim as he spoke about True Parents' life and the relationship between the physical and Spiritual World.

It was a glorious occasion with nearly 700 in attendance and many testified to the wisdom of True Mother in sending Rev. Kim as her emissary. His presence is that of a wise teacher who deeply cares for the well-being of his students and his vast experience and keen insight into the life of True Parents enables him to effectively convey his message with clarity. He spoke for about two hours, and his content and heart were so deep that the crowd stayed engrossed throughout his message.

The local Metro Music Ministry thrilled the packed room with a six song set. Emcee Shinnan Goto welcomed everyone and guided everyone in singing along with the Cheon Il Guk National Anthem video. Rev. Angelika Selle, President of WFWP -USA, gave a beautiful invocation and Dr. Michael Balcomb, President of FFWPU-USA, energized everyone with his enthusiasm. Dr. Ki Hoon Kim, Continental Director of FFWPU, gave an overview of the newly published *Cheong Seong Gyeong* and displayed a copy of the beautiful new edition. In order for all those in the room to catch the spirit of the "We Are Happy People" video, Dr. Balcomb jumped to the microphone to read the English text while True Mother spoke on the video. Dr. Chang Shik Yang, UPF International Chairman and Vice-President of FFWPU International, introduced the details of Rev. Kim's life and ministry. Because of the value of many of the providential activities in which Rev. Kim participated, the crowd regularly applauded the accomplishments that Dr. Yang described.

Throughout his speech Rev. Kim referred specifically to dates and places of importance in the life of True Father, which was the basis for explaining the purpose and meaning of those activities. He rarely referred to notes and, thus was able to constantly engage the audience with his warm and focused attention.

There was a constant referral to the Spirit World in his address. His simple, clear explanations were of great benefit to many in the audience who were raised in the more secular and materialistic Western hemisphere. Rev. Kim's reasonable and lucid descriptions of the relationship between the physical world and the Spirit World enabled us to appreciate the importance of using our time and resources to create a heavenly environment that will improve everyone's lives.

To conclude, Pastor Miilhan Stephens of the New Hope Church in Maryland wrapped up with "what this testimony means for us now." Since the program was a unique opportunity to gather the entire District One community, outgoing District Pastors Henri and Loretta Schauffler were honored along with the incoming interim District One Pastors Ernest and Keiko Patton. The event officially concluded with a photo showing the crowd that was able to be in the room, but because of the great respect that so many in the audience have for Pres. Kim, he was the center of group photos for another 20 minutes as people who had worked with him thronged to greet him.
