True Parents' Entrance into Cheon Jeong Gung and their Coronation as the Cosmic King and Queen of Peace (June 13, 2006)

On June 13, 2006, True Parents' entrance into Cheon Jeong Gung and their coronation as the Cosmic King and Queen of Peace happened at Cheon Jeong Gung, Cheongpyeong, Gyeonggi Province. Around 30,000 people gathered in the outdoor plaza of Cheon Jeong Gung, significant foreign political leaders, leaders of other faiths and our members. Peace ambassadors from 120 countries presented True Parents with crowns designed according to the local style in each country. Through his speech, "Cheon II Guk is the Ideal Heavenly Kingdom of Eternal Peace," True Father emphasized his hope that all people live as peace-loving citizens.
