An Important Invitation to Korea

We have just received an important and exciting invitation from True Mother to join her at the Cheongshim Peace World Center on Sunday December 15th for the final major event of 2013. It is a "Victory Rally" for 2013, to bring unity of Korea, Japan and America and also in support of the peaceful Reunification of Korea, and the wider cause of peace in Northeast Asia, recently much in the news.

Up to 15,000 people will attend, including a delegation of 200 from Japan and 30 from the USA.

The main event will take place Sunday morning from 10am-12pm, and will be followed by a celebratory luncheon. There may be some additional programs on Sunday afternoon in the Chung Pyung area, including an opportunity to review our national strategic plan for 2014. We will also try to organize a short "meet and greet" for the faculty of the Universal Peace Academy based at Cheongshim Seminary. On Monday 16th, our US Delegation will make a trip together (details to follow) and hold other short briefings. I am sure we will have a great experience!

Arrivals should be on Friday, December 13th or the morning of Saturday, December 14th. Departures are anytime on Tuesday, December 17th. HSA-UWC will be responsible for all costs of accommodation and meals *in Korea*, but participants (or the organizations they represent) <u>must cover the costs of air travel</u>.

It is a great honor to receive this important invitation from True Parents. America will respond well. In order to facilitate a prompt mobilization, I recommend the following quotas:
