Boon-Bong-Wang Dr. Bo Hi Pak's response

to the 46 members who signed the "December 13th Joint Resolution of the Mongolian Peace and Unification Movement"

I was shocked when I saw the "Joint Resolution of the Mongolian Peace and Unification Movement" dated December 13, 2010. I felt sorry for the more than 1,000 pure and innocent Mongolian members. I fervently prayed for God's forgiveness for the 46 so-called leaders who had signed this resolution.

My response in this letter is restricted to those 46 who signed the resolution. It should not be construed as being directed to the 1,000-plus Unificationists in Mongolia, many of whom may not be aware of these facts. I am convinced that if they were, they would not subscribe to this resolution, which can be regarded as a violent act.

The signatories elucidated seven points in a declaratory fashion, stating that it was their "resolution." Thus, in a similar fashion I would like to respond to their resolution with seven points.

Response from the Boon-Bong-Wang Dr. Bo Hi Pak

1. In your resolution you mentioned "True Parents" eleven times. This is truly regrettable and sad. You are not qualified to even speak of "True Parents." How can you talk about True Parents' dream and their will or even think that you are qualified to do so when you do not obey True Parents' instructions?

If you wish to call yourselves the true children of True Parents, you must first obey True Parents' instructions. True Parents have taught us about "absolute faith, absolute love and absolute obedience" which is stated in verse eight of the Family Pledge. You should first put this verse into practice, become True Parents' children and then talk about True Parents.

2. You wrote this resolution under the name, "Mongolian Peace and Unification Movement." True Parents have never established such a group or organization. You have privately created an organization and group using a plausible name and are deceiving others by pretending to be the principal body of the Unification Church and of the Unification movement.

True Parents founded the "Unification Church" (formerly known as the Holy Spirit Association for the Unification of World Christianity) as a religious movement and established the "Universal Peace Federation (UPF)" as a vehicle for the Abel UN movement.

You have created a private organization that has nothing to do with True Parents, and it is behaving as if it is one of the organizations established by True Parents. Nobody will be taken in by such hypocrisy and deceptive tactics.

3. I visited Mongolia on December 8 after receiving the mission of Boon-Bong-Wang to Mongolia under True Parents' personal direction. It shows a lack of courtesy on the part of the Mongolia leaders that they conspired to prevent anyone from meeting me at the airport or hotel. However, this is not a problem as I was not going to Mongolia to be welcomed. Still, to reject a person appointed as Boon-Bong-Wang by True Parents is, I fear, tantamount to rejecting True Parents and being disobedient to True Parents' direct instructions.

Furthermore, while I was praying at the Mongolian headquarters church, some among you used force to damage the car that I was using. In each sentence of your statement you talk about true love, but I would like to ask you; "Do you believe that such actions are an expression of true love? Are you people of faith, or are you people of violence?"

Until the day of my death, Mongolia is now my second homeland. My mission is to love Mongolia and love the people of Mongolia. With the faithful in Mongolia, we shall build the kingdom of heaven in Mongolia. I shall offer my life in order to carry out my mission as the Boon-Bong-Wang to Mongolia in spite of your opposition or rejection.

4. In the Bible, Jesus said, "I am the vine; you are the branches. (John 15:5)" If any branch does not remain connected to the vine, it shall wither away and die. True Parents are the vine and we are all branches. The faithful in Mongolia are all branches of this vine. If you wish to attain salvation and eternal life, you must not be separated from True Parents, the vine. If you were, that would mean death.

Brothers and sisters of Mongolia!

Do not think that you can live on your own, apart from the vine. The only way for you to live is by following the direct path connected to True Parents. That path is one of obeying True Parents' words and instructions.

You who are like lost lambs!

Awaken! Find life! Seek eternal life! True life flows exclusively from True Parents. Do not tragically discard the precious blessing of eternal life that Heaven is conferring on you through True Parents. Your eternal life is already commencing from this moment. Why do you carelessly throw away your soul and body into the pits of death!

5. Of the many things you stated in the resolution, you are right about one. I am referring to number six of your resolution.

"All assets and providential institutions of the Unification Movement are not the possession of any one individual or organization. They belong to God and all humanity and must be used for God's providence and human-kind. We will not allow any attempts by any individual or organization to use their power to make these assets into their own, and we will strongly stand against them."

These words speak the truth. Yet, all of you and those who guide you are the very group who are violating this truth.

Isn't UCI in the United States an accumulation of church assets representing the sweat and blood True Parents have invested for more than half a century? By whose hands is UCI now being encroached on? Who are the people who have taken UCI from True Parents' hands? Who is manipulating the vast assets such as the Yeoui-do land and Central City in Korea? Are you unaware of the fury of the millions of members worldwide? Are you ignorant of this? Are you trying to hide these facts with flowery ex-

pressions? Why don't you recognize the foolishness of your acts? It is like trying to block the sun with the palm of your hand. Or is it that you know but pretend ignorance?

6. Are you trying to turn a blind eye to your leaders' rebellious acts against True Parents by saying such elaborate words? Are you trying to gloss over their rebellious acts against True Parents and believe in this lie?

You have to open your eyes and honestly look at the core of the problem!

The core of the problem is not the alleged strife between brothers in the True Family, or a power-struggle. The core of the problem is a battle between "obedience and disobedience." It is a struggle between those who believe True Parents to be the messiah and savior and are absolutely obedient to them, and those who do not believe True Parents to be the one and only savior and disobey them. Why does disobedience occur? You only speak of True Parents, but your soul does not believe them to be the messiah and savior. That is why you can disobey them.

On which side do you stand?

On the side of those who are obedient to True Parents,

Or on the side of those who are not?

Place your hand on your chest and ask your conscience. The answer will be crystal clear. Please do not deceive your conscience.
