Greetings from UPF International.

We recently concluded a very successful interfaith conference in Amman, Jordan, addressing the crisis in Syria. You can see the report at the following link: upf.org/upf-news/141-africa-middle-east/5431-amman-conference-on-prospects-for-dialogue-and-reconciliation-in-syria

In addition, following directly after the Amman, Jordan interfaith conference, we convened a similar meeting in Jerusalem, which was equally productive. What is most encouraging about these recent conferences is the extent to which the participants want to support UPF and help UPF take a more active leadership role in global affairs. This speaks to the growing appreciation and respect for the work you and our National Chapters are doing in your Regions.

As mentioned in the memo of October 15, UPF International will organize a program in Jerusalem in December as part of our ongoing Middle East Peace Initiative. This program is being convened on the 10th anniversary of the interfaith program held in December 2003, which was directly guided by our Founders, and which affirmed and honored the legacy of Jesus, together with Moses and Mohammed. We will gather again in December 2013 to carry forward the legacy and spirit of that special program, which was witnessed by nearly 20,000 people at Independence Park in Jerusalem.

I want to convey the overall plan, which has been worked out with Dr. Chang Shik Yang, UPF's International Chairman, along with Dr. Young Tack Yang, Regional Chair, UPF Middle East, and Mr. Hod Ben Zvi, UPF Israel.

Program: The program will consist of **two components**, as follows:

A. High Level Interfaith Conference: approximately 20-30 interfaith leaders and experts in Middle East geopolitical affairs will gather to discuss, "*Religion, Peace and International Relations in the Middle East: Prospects for Conflict Resolution, Peace and Stability.*"

Dates: December 19-22, 2013

Participants: UPF Regions should recommend high level participants [religious leaders, academics, political scientists with expertise in the Middle East, etc.] who have capacity to contribute in a substantial way to the success of the conference. There is no set quota for Regions. Rather, participants will be selected based on their level of expertise and potential contribution to the quality of the conference. Recommendations must be submitted by November 15, 2013.

Airfare Policy: For high level participants who are approved by UPF Headquarters, some or all of the airfare may be covered.

Hotel and Meal Policy: Hotel and meal expenses will be covered for approved participants.

Administration: UPF International, together with UPF Israel, will organize the Interfaith Conference.

B. Religious Youth Service: 20-30 young participants will be invited to participate in an RYS program which features interfaith education, leadership development and community service.

Dates: December 18-23, 2013

Participants: Each Region is encouraged to send 2-3 young leaders to join this program. It is fine if our own 2nd Generation are included, but we hope that the ratio of 2nd Gen to those from other religious traditions is about 40% to 60%.

Airfare Policy: UPF International will provide an airfare grant of \$500 for approved participants coming from USA, Europe, Middle East, Northeast, and an \$800 grant for those coming from Africa, Asia, Japan, Korea, Latin American and Oceania. Participants are required to cover the remainder of the airfare costs not covered by the grant. Grants will be distributed through the regional office.

Hotel and Meal Policy: RYS participants will be required to pay a \$250 registration fee, which will cover their meals, their simple accommodations at an inexpensive hotel or hostel, and ground transportation.

Administration: UPF International, together with UPF Israel, will manage the administration of the RYS program.

Please give serious consideration to participation in these programs that pay respect to our Founders' legacy in promoting peace and reconciliation among the religions of the Middle East and all the religions of the world.

On behalf of the Universal Peace Federation, we are pleased to invite you to participate in a special consultation that addresses the current crisis in Syria and other points of conflict in the Middle East. We are already painfully aware of the magnitude of the current crisis, the loss of life, the displacement of persons, and the horrors of war. We all fear the potential for this crisis to escalate even further into a wider conflict, involving other countries in the region, as well as major power like Russia, the European Union and the USA.

This special consultation will bring together approximately 20 religious leaders, academics and Middle East experts. The theme of the conference is "Religion, Peace and International Relations in the Middle East: Prospects for Conflict Resolution, Peace and Stability." The consultation is being convened in Jerusalem on **December 19-22, 2013**, and builds on the foundation of our recent conference in Amman, Jordan which was held on October 11-13. There is growing, yet still inadequate awareness of the important role which religions could and should play in international relations. Some of the obstacles are related to outdated attitudes toward religion on the part of the mainstream community of international relations experts, and others are related to religion's own inadequacies and unfortunate practices. These obstacles can be overcome, and religion can be a significant and constructive player in global affairs. The consultation will provide an opportunity for us to consider the way in which religious believers of diverse faiths and ethnic or national backgrounds can come together in a spirit of harmony and cooperation to speak with one voice of the need for dialogue, cooperation, and peace.

Throughout the history of UPF's Middle East Peace Initiative, we have consistently encouraged interfaith dialogue and cooperation. In addition, UPF has for thirteen years been advocating for the United Nations to build within its system an interfaith council of spiritual elders. We admire and are encouraged by initiatives taken up by King Adbullah II of Jordan, Pope Francis, King Abdullah Bin Abdulaziz, H.E. Nasser Al Nassir of the UN's Alliance of Civilizations, and many others who affirm the need for interfaith, intercultural and inter-civilizational dialogue and cooperation.

With this in mind, the consultation provides a golden opportunity for us to come together as an international and interreligious group of leaders from various sectors, to listen and learn, to share and reflect on how we can serve as relevant, constructive stakeholders in the search for a solution to the crisis in Syria and the wider Middle East.

We hope you will join us in Jerusalem. We look forward to your favorable reply.
