"This is how we know what love is: Jesus Christ laid down his life for us." *1 John 3:16*

Kerry Williams, Education Director for Sanctuary USA, gave the sermon on Resurrection Sunday. Jesus was mocked and ridiculed on Good Friday. He prayed, "forgive them for they know not what they do." In a speech Father gave in 1973, "God's Hope for Man," (10/20/1973), he said

Jesus Christ was lord over all life because of his unparalleled form of loving, giving and sacrifice. He remains the Lord forever!" In dozens of speeches he gave in the 1950s and 1960s he poured out his heart to his disciples, calling them to a deeper relationship with Jesus, like a bride attends her bridegroom.

When we come before Christ, what happens? We see our sin and our darkness, but then we see His light. Kerry remembers about Father speaking in the New Yorker Grand Ballroom. A top leader confessed his sin publicly, but Father only shed tears.



Father prayed for his torturers. Democrat congressman Donald Fraser accused Sun Myung Moon and the Unification Church of being a tool of the Korean CIA. The day Father was vindicated. He asked, "how many of you prayed for Donald Fraser?" The most significant is the resurrection of his principle and unconditional love.

The light of Christ revealed the nature of True Adam. The word of God is our light. Ever since the Fall, God has been working to bring His dead son back to life.



Kerry then showed a music video by Sufjan Stevens, "[To Be Alone with You](#)," which is about spending time and developing a relationship with Jesus.

We are forgiven and saved by Jesus' love and sacrifice. The next step is when we realize we must live as Jesus did. As stated in 1 John 2:3-6, "We know that we have come to know him if we keep his commands... whoever claims to live in him must live as Jesus did."
